Please read each page of this guide carefully during installation, following along one step at a time.



Use soapy water and a cloth, then the alcohol wipes provided, to clean the glass (Fig.1). Allow time for the glass to dry fully before moving to the next step.



Peel the cover from the adhesive strip on the back of the Stick2Go rail (Fig.2). Place the rail against the glass at the top of the window - hold the top edge of the rail against the glass to avoid accidentally sticking it in place while you straighten it (Fig.3).




Press the rail back against the glass and hold for around 30 seconds until it adheres (Fig.4).


Note that after 12 hours the adhesive will be fully cured.

Rest the blind's depression end (opposite to the controls) in the circular slot in the corresponding bracket (Fig.5).



Push against the depression end and raise the control end, locking the rectangular studs on the end of the controls into the slots in the other bracket (Fig.6).




Young children can be strangled by loops in pull cords, chains, tapes and inner cords that operate the product.

To avoid strangulation and entanglement, keep cords out of the reach of young children. Cords may become wrapped around a child's neck.

Move beds, cots and furniture away from window covering cords.

Do not tie cords together. Make sure cords do not twist and create a loop.




Lastly, install the child-safety clip on the frame. Peel the cover from the adhesive pad on the back of the clip (Fig.7) then, keeping the control chain taut, press the clip back against the window frame and hold for 30 seconds until it adheres (Fig.8).

And that's it! Your beautiful new blind is installed and ready to enjoy.

Once your blinds are installed we recommend plugging in the motor for each, to allow it to fully charge before use. Plug the charging cable (included) into the motor charging port (Fig.9) and allow to charge until the LED on the charger plug turns green. Do not over-charge, as this can damage the battery.

On the front of the swing tag that comes with each blind (Fig.10), you'll find a handy QR code you can scan with your phone. Scan this to download the SmartView app - you'll be setting up your blinds in moments!
